Regular Meeting Minutes
July 23, 2018
City Hall @ 6:00 p.m.

CALL TO ORDER

- Mayor Christensen called the July 23, 2018 Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

Mayor Christensen announced that a Quorum was present.

Commissioner Mizell made a motion to approve the June 25, 2018 Regular Meeting minutes, the July 2 and July 9, 2018 Special Meeting minutes, June 2018 Transactions, July 2018 unpaid bills, and account balance reports; Commissioner Reese seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried.

Commissioner Reese reported that he has the cameras for the park; but needs to buy some mounting equipment.

Commissioner Mizell reported that the storage building has been installed at the Park with a city padlock.

Commission Wilson said that items from the old building at the park need to be moved; so the old building can be destroyed. Commissioner Mizell plans to use some of the old wood to build shelves in the new storage building.

Commissioner Strother said the Pike Street rock has been busted up at the tight spot. She still needs fill dirt. The Angle Avenue grate has been repaired.

City Clerk Report – Delinquent tax update report was provided; total reduced to \$1,115.89.

Mayor Christensen announced that the KLC Conference is September 17-20. Please contact Clerk Whelan for registration.

Mayor Christensen announced that the Bluegrass Tomorrow Celebration is Thursday, October 11 at the Kentucky Castle in Versailles. There will be dinner and program speaker. The cost is \$1,000.00

for a table of 8 or \$150.00 for individual tickets. Commissioner Reese made a motion to approve to get a table; Commissioner Wilson seconded, all in favor; motion passes.

- Mayor Christensen discussed the fireworks policy sample he distributed. Commissioner Strother will review and create a new ordinance for Sadieville.

- Commissioner Reese reported that they did not have a Police Committee meeting this month. He also reported that he gave attorney Ben Willis three new policies they would like him to review before implementing. Commissioner Reese also reported that work was done with the office of Personnel Management and the Cabinet for Health and Family Services.

- Police Chief Bruner provided a report. He reported that he will be putting up a speed trailer next Wednesday. Commissioner Reese and Chief Bruner will be looking for the best placement and will try to get a schedule for the speed trailer. Chief Bruner is also looking into installing a crosswalk on Pike Street; from stairs to parking area.

- Commissioner Strother reported that she would like signage “Road Narrows” for the narrow spot on Pike St. if the state will do it. She will check into it.

- Commissioner Mizell reported that he will have trees trimmed on Vine St.

- Commissioner Wilson reported that Commissioner Reese will repair the lighting at the Pavilion.

- Commissioner Strother reported that we will be losing Alex Smith in August. Commissioner Wilson said she will take over those responsibilities.

- Commissioner Strother provided letters drafted for residents regarding the repair of the rockwall on Pike St. Attorney Willis will review the letters. Commissioner Mizell will notify the state of the start date of work. The City already has the encroachment permit. Commissioner Mizell will check on temporary stop lights.

- Commissioner Strother reported that if they are to put “No Parking” signs along Pike St., they must be behind sidewalk; no permit necessary. She will draft ordinance as no parking area; 5 minute loading zone for library express only.

- Commissioner Strother gave an estimate of \$1,160.70 for repairing Eagle Bend Bridge. Mayor Christensen made a motion to approve up to \$1,300.00 for the bridge repair; Commissioner Reese seconded; all in favor; motion passes.

- Commissioner Strother discussed Angle Avenue and how the road is deteriorated by the salt barn entrance; also the road is breaking off over on College Street. Commissioner Strother will bring an

estimate next month.

- Commissioner Mizell reported there is a live electric line down on Vine St.; it was reported that they will fix it on Tuesday. If it isn't fixed by then, Commissioner Mizell will contact KU.
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to go into Executive Session; Commissioner Mizell seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to come out of Executive Session; Commissioner Strother seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carries. Executive Session ended 7:30 p.m
- Mayor Christensen moved to authorize the city attorney to close out nuisance claim; Commissioner Reese seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carries.
- Mayor Christensen discussed reclassifying the clerk position. The proposal is the position to be full time with comprehensive package, pay and benefits; and adds duties to the position. Commissioner Mizell made a motion to approve the reclassification; Commissioner Wilson seconded; all in favor; motion passes. Mayor Christensen will meet with existing clerk to discuss.
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to adjourn; Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion. The Regular Meeting adjourned at 7:34 p.m.
