Workshop Meeting Minutes  
March 18 , 2019

□ CALL TO ORDER

- Mayor Wagoner called the March 18, 2019 Workshop Meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.
- Mayor Wagoner invited everyone to participate in a moment of silence.

- Mayor Wagoner determined a quorum was present.
  - Mayor Wagoner stated that this meeting is a workshop meeting where there will be no voting and no decisions. It is a meeting for each commissioner to talk about their projects with other commissioners to outline the steps to move forward with the projects.
  - Parks and Recreation Commissioner Stamper talked about the grant she is applying for in order to complete the rubber mulch on the playground. She would like to install some benches along the walking path and the grant would also apply. She also talked about the area by the pavillion which could also be covered by the grant.
  - Public Safety commissioner Reese and Police Chief Bruner are working on renovating the police station in order to accommodate Scott County Sheriff's Department officers who are planning to increase patrol in Sadieville.
  - Police Chief Bruner talked to the commission about his conversation with EMA regarding Sadieville's desire for EMA to locate in the basement of city hall. Commissioner Reese and Police Chief Bruner will look into creating a resolution to the necessary needs for EMA to have a location in Sadieville.
  - Mayor Wagoner made a suggestion to install the camera system at the park also at City Hall.
  - Streets commissioner Southworth spoke about various ideas and issues in the Eagle Bend area. Commissioner Southworth also talked about addressing an issue on Angle Avenue, Railroad Lane, Baird's Alley, and Sadie's Alley.

- Public Works commissioner Cannon talked about renovating the bathrooms at the park. Until they are completed, Commissioner Stamper will order a couple of portable bathrooms to be located in the park. Commissioner Cannon is planning to call someone at Scott County parks to get ideas about the bathroom repairs.
- City Clerk Strother discussed the cost for city clerk training and obtaining certification.
- Mayor Wagoner talked about the ideas and plans for developing the interstate exchange. There was a meeting of landowners, city and county officials, real estate personnel, etc.
- Commissioner Stamper made motion to adjourn at approximately 7:43p.m.; Commissioner Southworth seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
