Special Meeting Minutes

□ CALL TO ORDER

- Mayor Wagoner called the September 9, 2019 Special Meeting to order at 6:01p.m.
- Mayor Wagoner invited everyone to participate in a moment of silence.
- City Clerk Strother conducted the roll call.

- Mayor Wagoner determined a quorum was present.
- Mayor Wagoner introduced the first agenda item regarding the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2019-05- An Ordinance Levying the City of Sadieville Ad Valorem Taxes on All Property Within the Taxing Jurisdiction.
- Attorney Stephens conducted the 2nd reading of Ordinance 2019-05- An Ordinance Levying the City of Sadieville Ad Valorem Taxes on All Property Within the Taxing Jurisdiction. Commissioner Reese made a motion to accept Ordinance 2019-05 as read; Commissioner Cannon seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Mayor Wagoner talked about the electrical work that needed to be done on Main Street to accommodate the electrical needs of the Sadieville Celebration. Commissioner Southworth stated that Younger Electric will perform the electrical work for less than \$2,000.00. Mayor Wagoner stated the electric was at this location in the past and it had been disconnected. The Commission discussed. Commissioner Reese made a motion to spend up to \$3,000.00 to restore the electricity; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Mayor Wagoner introduced the next item on the agenda related to the police department. Commissioner Reese talked about the estimates received from Bachman for leasing police vehicles. The Commission discussed. The Commission decided to discuss again at a future meeting so that the Police department could provide more information.

- Mayor Wagoner invited two candidates for part-time police officers for the City of Sadieville to introduce themselves, talk about their experience, and their desire to work for the City of Sadieville. The Commission asked the candidates questions. Mayor Wagoner talked about the needs of the community and the ordinances that needed to be enforced. Commissioner Reese made a motion to move into executive session KRS 61.810 (1) (f); Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to leave executive session; Commissioner Cannon seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to hire part-time the two police officer candidates, Brandon Blair and Ken Spera, at a pay rate of \$15.50 per hour with no benefits; Commissioner Cannon seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes. Brandon Blair and Ken Spera accepted the employment offer. City Attorney Matt Stephens conducted the swearing-in of Brandon Blair and Ken Spera as police officers for the City of Sadieville.
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to adjourn at approximately 7:03pm; Commissioner Cannon seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
