- Mayor Wagoner called the February 3, 2020 Special Meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.
- Mayor Wagoner invited everyone to participate in a moment of silence.
- City Clerk Strother conducted the roll call.

- Mayor Wagoner introduced the agenda item regarding the second and final reading of Ordinance 2020-01- An Ordinance Relating to Alcohol Beverage Control.
