

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- Commissioner Kaplan made a motion to approve the minutes for the regular September 22, 2025, meeting minutes; Commissioner Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
 - Commissioner Toth made a motion to approve the financial reports with the addition of \$1884.73 for Attorney Obermeyer, \$2876.25 for Wood Line, and \$615.00 for Government Utility Technical Service to the unpaid bills report; Commissioner Blevins seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
 - **Mayor:** Commissioner Kaplan made a motion to approve Municipal Order 2025-07, recognition of city holiday; Commissioner Toth seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
 - **Mayor:** Commissioner Toth made a motion to approve the purchase of a new printer for city hall from Electronic Business Machines in the amount of \$2259.70; Commissioner Kaplan seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
 - **Attorney:** Commissioner Kaplan made a motion to approve Municipal Order 2025-08, Memorandum of Understanding with the Scott County Fiscal Court for fire marshal services; Commissioner Blevins seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.

 - **Public Safety:** Commissioner Kaplan made a motion to approve \$10,590.32 for the purchase of Axon body cameras for the Sadieville Police Department (consisting of \$2118.08/year from 2026 to 2030); Commissioner Toth seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
 - **Public Safety:** Commissioner Kaplan made a motion to approve the application to the KLC Liability Grant for the body cameras; Commissioner Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.

- **Public Works:** Commissioner Kaplan made a motion to approve \$1778.00 for Computer Solutions and Innovations to connect all security cameras to one network; Commissioner Blevins seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
