- Mayor Wagoner determined a quorum was present.
- Mayor Wagoner stated that this meeting is a workshop meeting where there will be no voting and no
 decisions. It is a meeting for each commissioner to talk about their projects with other commissioners

- Parks and Recreation Commissioner Stamper talked about the grant she is applying for in order to
 complete the rubber mulch on the playground. She would like to install some benches along the
 walking path and the grant would also apply. She also talked about the area by the pavillion which
 could also be covered by the grant.
- Public Safety commissioner Reese and Police Chief Bruner are working on renovating the police station in order to accommodate Scott County Sheriff's Department officers who are planning to increase patrol in Sadieville.

 park. Commissioner Cannon is planning to call someone at Scott County parks to get ideas about the
 bathroom repairs.
