

**City of Sadieville**  
Regular Meeting Minutes  
May 21, 2018  
City Hall @ 6:00 p.m.

- CALL TO ORDER
  - Mayor Pro Tem Strother called the May 21, 2018 Regular Meeting to order at 6:02 p.m.
  
- ROLL CALL
  - Mayor Christensen Absent
  - Streets Commissioner Present
  - Parks and Recreation Commissioner Present
  - Public Works Commissioner Absent
  - Public Safety Commissioner Present
  - City Attorney Ben Willis Present
  - Police Chief Bobby Bruner Present
  - Clerk Sandy Whelan Present
  
- Mayor Pro Tem Strother announced that a Quorum was present.
  
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to approve the April 23, 2018 Regular Meeting minutes, April 2018 Transactions, May 2018 unpaid bills, and account balance reports; Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion; all in favor; motion carried.
  
- Commissioner Reese stated that he will have the cameras installed at park, as soon as decisions are made on placement.
  
- Mayor Pro Tem Strother reported that she is waiting on a date from C&R for the paving of Eagle Bend. She also reported that she is looking into the Intersection on Angle Avenue.
  
- Commissioner Wilson reported that the new storage building at the park has not been installed yet due to the ground being too wet.
  
- Mayor Pro Tem Strother opened bids for the Pike Street wall repair. The first bid was from Noe Herrera – bid of \$19,000.00; no details. The second bid was from James Miles Construction, Inc.; estimate of \$28,600.00 with details of work to be performed. Mayor Pro Tem Strother is responsible for calling utilities. Commissioner Reese made a motion to accept the bid from James Miles Construction; Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion; all in favor; Roll call vote; Mayor Pro Tem Strother – yes; Commission Wilson – yes; Commissioner Reese– yes; motion passes. Commissioner Strother mentioned there are two types of wall caps; you can cap it with a large stone that they put on top of wall, a little more expensive, or they can soldier cap – all in a row standing up. Commissioner Reese made a motion to soldier cap; Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
  
- City Clerk Report – Delinquent tax update report was provided; total remained at \$1548.00.

- Commissioner Strother has applied for an AARP grant to help with sidewalk between City Hall and the Park on 32. She had previously applied for a grant for the sidewalk, but it requires a \$40,000.00 match for the project. This new grant will help with the funding of the \$40,000.00.
  
- Commissioner Strother reported that the city can repair Eagle Bend bridge; the work doesn't need to be bid out.
  
- Police Chief Bruner completed a verbal Police Chief Report.
  
- Commissioner Reese made a motion to adjourn; Commissioner Wilson seconded the motion. The Regular Meeting adjourned at 6:27 p.m.
