CITY OF SADIEVILLE ORDINANCE 2023-04

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ZONE CHANGE OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED AT

170 PORTER ROAD, FROM A-1 TO B-2.

WHEREAS, the application of Kentucky Lodging and Development Co., Inc, having been properly

filed with the Georgetown-Scott County Planning Commission to change the zoning classification

on certain real estate in Scott County, Kentucky, consisting of approximately 1.662 acres located at

170 Porter Road from Agricultural (A-1) to Highway Commercial (B-2), and,

WHEREAS, this matter having been considered by the Georgetown-Scott County Planning and

Zoning staff, and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of Sadieville, Kentucky, having considered the record of the

Georgetown-Scott County Planning Commission, including without limitation, the application,

supporting evidence, findings, recommendations, and conditions in ZMA-2023-27, and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SADIEVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS

FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Commission of Sadieville, Kentucky after discussion and deliberation of the

record and recommendation from the Planning Commission, and consideration of other issues,

information, evidence, and testimony as set forth above, does hereby adopt the record of the

Planning Commission at a public hearing held on July 13, 2023. Pursuant to KRS 100.211 the

approval of this zone classification change including the conditions recommended by the Planning

Commission, is approved and adopted by the Sadieville City Commission.

Section 2: The Zoning Ordinance - Georgetown-Scott County, Kentucky (including Sadieville) be

amended to show a change in the zoning classification from Agricultural (A-1) to Highway

Commercial (B-2) for the real property within the Proposed Zone Change Boundary described on

the attached Conceptual Plan: Dollar General Store.

Section 3: The Georgetown-Scott County Planning Commission is hereby directed to show this

amendment on the official zoning map of Georgetown, Scott County (including Sadieville) and to

make reference to the number of this ordinance of such change.
