- Mayor Wagoner called the February 27, 2023, Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- Mayor Wagoner invited everyone to participate in a moment of silence.
- City Clerk Centers conducted the roll call.

- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the minutes for the January 23, 2023, regular meeting; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.

- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the financial reports with the addition of \$819.96 for Attorney Obermeyer; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.

- **Mayor:** Mayor Wagoner nominated Commissioner Debra Stamper for Mayor Pro Tem; Commissioner Cornett seconded the nomination; roll call vote; motion passed.



- **Mayor:** Discussed meeting attendance policies for elected officials. Three missed meetings within a 12 month period is considered neglect of duty.
- **Mayor:** Discussion regarding “children at play” and speed limit signs on Burgess Heights.
- **Mayor:** The comprehensive plan regarding the properties around the interstate exchange were discussed with a citizen.
- **City Attorney:** Attorney Obermeyer did send an email regarding the insurance waiver for the proposed 5k. He stated everything will need to be voted on and the citizen who is wanting to do this needs to be present.

- **City Attorney:** Attorney Obermeyer drafted a letter regarding past due property taxes. City Clerk will send him a copy of the ordinance regarding the property taxes.
- **Public Safety:** Commissioner Halsey made a motion to increase emergency response call-in pay from 2 hours to 4 hours minimum for police officers and maintenance; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Public Safety:** Chief Bruner is going to set a meeting with EMA to discuss severe weather plans and train derailment response plan. He is planning to attend a free safety seminar provided by Norfolk Southern. He is also going to research personal protective equipment needed for a train derailment.
- **Public Works:** Commissioner Cornett has spoken with a company and is waiting for the bid on the demolition of 615 Pike Street. Total of \$15,000 will get it to the dirt, \$13,000 will get it to the foundation. Contractor recommends the \$13,000 bid first because then a retaining wall would need to be built to contain the dirt and sidewalk, then he could come back and take down to the foundation for the remaining \$2000.
- **Public Works:** Commissioner Cornett stated that there seems to be a lot of community interest and volunteers for restoring Mt. Pleasant Church. He is thinking maybe some kind of community center along with keeping the history of the church. He has received positive feedback.
- **Parks & Recreation:** Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve \$500 to purchase park supplies such as cleaning supplies, soap, soap dispensers, changing table, new bathroom signs and a volleyball net; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Parks & Recreation:** Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve \$595 for a forklift rental for splashpad equipment unloading; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Streets, Trails and Walkways:** Commissioner Stanley is absent.
- **City Clerk Report:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve the increase from \$14.99/mo to \$15.99/mo for monthly Zoom payment; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **City Clerk Report:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to have the drug drop off box removed from city hall; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **City Clerk Report:** Commissioner Halsey made a motion to approve \$250 to purchase business cards for Commissioner Cornett; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- Commissioner Cornett had to leave for a family emergency at 7:40 pm.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:42 p.m.; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
