□ CALL TO ORDER

- Mayor Wagoner called the February 28, 2022, Regular Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- Mayor Wagoner invited everyone to participate in a moment of silence.
- City Clerk Centers conducted the roll call.

□ ROLL CALL

- Parks and Recreation Commissioner Stamper: Present

- City Clerk Laura Centers: Present

- Mayor Wagoner determined a quorum was present.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the minutes for the January 24, 2022, regular meeting; Commissioner Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to accept the financial reports with the addition of the unpaid bills for Attorney Obermeyer for \$980.38; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Mayor:** We do not have the information to read the Municipal Road Aid yet.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the Spectrum Franchise bid; Commissioner Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **City Attorney:** He is currently working on the Habitat/Salt Barn plat.
- **Public Safety:** The police department is currently working on getting quotes for a 12' box trailer to use as emergency response. The current printer at the police station is old and needs replacement. Quotes will be obtained. Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve \$250 for road flares and printer paper for cruisers; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Public Works:** There appears to be rotting on the front wall of City Hall. Commissioner Epperson-Stanley will discuss this with the insurance agent before investigating further. The maintenance man has checked the hot water heaters at both City Hall and the Police Department, they are not made anymore. He is also currently working at Rosenwald School caulking the windows.
- **Parks & Recreation:** Commissioner Stamper will work in March getting the park and park bathrooms ready to open for the season. Commissioner Halsey made a motion to approve \$700 to

replace broken bathroom tiles and repair doorknobs at the bathrooms, purchase a new trash can and trash bags for park; Commissioner Epperson-Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.

- **Streets, Trails and Walkways:** Commissioner Stanley will discuss the boat ramp with Fish & Wildlife as this falls under their jurisdiction.
- **City Clerk:** Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve \$150 for the KY Municipal Clerk Training for City Clerk Centers to attend online; Commissioner Epperson Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:54 p.m.; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
