
- **Citizen Comments:** Citizens brought up concerns about development at the interstate exchange.
- Commissioner Freeman made a motion to approve the minutes for the April 24, 2023, regular meeting; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- Commissioner Freeman made a motion to approve the financial reports with the addition of \$1042.48 for Attorney Obermeyer; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- Mayor Wagoner made a motion to appoint Commissioner Jennifer Halsey as the ABC Administrator for the city; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **City Attorney:** Attorney Obermeyer gave updates on the Pike St lots and condemned properties.
- **Public Safety:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve \$300 for Commissioner Halsey to attend the Kentucky League of Cities Summit training; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Streets, Trails & Walkways:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve Jean Stanley and Chase Centers to continue to work on establishing a non-profit or board for tourism; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Streets, Trails & Walkways:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve \$100 for business cards for the tourism group; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Public Works:** Commissioner Cornett made a motion to change the previously allotted amount of \$1000 approved in the August 2022 meeting for the installation of electric outlets on Main Street

to the poles at Veteran's Park; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.

- **Parks & Recreation:** Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the quote from Woodline Fencing for \$8020 to install the fencing around the splash pad; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **Parks & Recreation:** Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve \$250 to purchase supplies for the park restrooms; Commissioner Cornett seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
- **City Clerk Report:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve \$204 for the VC3 bill to install new city hall computer; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passed.
