- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the minutes for the August 23, 2021, regular meeting; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to approve the minutes for the September 2, 2021, special meeting; Commissioner Epperson-Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Commissioner Stamper made a motion to accept the amended financial reports with \$1362.45 for Jason Obermeyer, Attorney and an amendment to James Miles Construction for \$7035.02; Commissioner Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- Mayor Wagoner made a motion to appoint Dann Smith to the position of Sadieville Representative for the Scott County Comprehensive Plan; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- **City Attorney:** The closing of the 856 Pike Street property sale happened today. He has a phone call into the lawyer who is representing the lead plaintiff regarding the Sadieville School.
- **Public Safety:** Nothing to report.
- **Public Works:** Commissioner Epperson-Stanley made a motion that the repair for (approximately of \$300) of the electric pole at 207 Main Street that happened during the festival be placed under the public works department; Commissioner Stamper seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes. She is still waiting for information on parts and repairs for the caboose.

- **Parks & Recreation:** Commissioner Stamper made a motion to set trick or treat for October 30th, from 6pm to 8pm; Commissioner Halsey seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- **Parks & Recreation:** Mayor Wagoner made a motion to approve \$800 for the Halloween event; Commissioner Stanley seconded the motion; all in favor; motion passes.
- **Streets, Trails and Walkways:** James Miles Construction is working on a estimates for the Angle Alley drainage ditch, stairway to propane tank along with the retaining wall at City Hall and Vine Street alley.
- **City Clerk:** Property taxes have arrived and will be going out in the mail soon. The city currently has around 600 hotspots out to customers.
- The Kentucky League of Cities conference that Mayor Wagoner was scheduled to attend and which money was reserved for has been cancelled.
