

ORDINANCE 2022-02  
CITY OF SADIEVILLE  
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ANIMAL WASTE

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF SADIEVILLE:**


The custodian of every animal shall immediately remove any excreta deposited by his animal on public walks, streets, recreation areas, or private property belonging to another.


Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a civil offense which shall be enforced by the code enforcement board, hearing officers, code enforcement officers, citation officers, law enforcement officers and other persons duly authorized to investigate and enforce the violations through investigation, inspection, and issuance of citations.

The initial fine for a violation of this ordinance shall be \$50.00. For each seven days or portion thereof beyond the remediation date that the violation remains unremedied, \$50.00 shall be added to the initial fine until the violation is remedied by the responsible person or is abated by the city or until the total fine reaches \$500.00.
